Match	Rounds	Time	Max score	Details
Application	10	90 secs	50	Slow fire precision event. Start prone with loaded rifle, on command engage target
Trinity	15	3 x 60 secs	75	Shot from Standing, sitting/kneeling and prone. One minute per position with 5 rounds from each position with time to reload.
Fumble	10	45	50	Start standing with empty rifle, action forward, in strong hand, empty magazine in weak hand and rounds loose on mat. On command load magazine, load and action rifle then engage target from the standing position. A cat shooters can have one 5 rd. magazine loaded
Action M	10	60	50	Start with rifle on mat, shooter standing. Rifle loaded with 5 rd. magazine inserted but bolt forward on chamber empty and safety off. On command, drop to prone, action rifle and fire two rounds, stand to fire 2 rds. Then drop to kneeling or sitting to fire 1 round, stay in position and reload with a second 5 round magazine then fire 1 more round, stand to fire 2 rds., then drop to prone to fire last 2 rounds.
Kaitoke Turnaround	20	20	50	Start standing 2 meters behind rifle. Rifle staged on mat with magazine of 20 rounds out, bolt closed on empty chamber, safety off. On command, drop to prone load, action rifle and engage target
Thin red Line	20	60	100	Targets: 1 x fig 12, 1 x fig 14, 3 x steel plates. Start Standing alert with rifle loaded with a max of 20 rounds. On command drop plates from standing position then engage fig 12 and fig 14 with remaining rounds from any position. Scoring. All hits on fig 14 = V, fig 12 as per normal, plates = 5. There must be hits on both targets to count.

- **Two classes:** A cat and E cat (proof of endorsement required)
- Matches are for centerfire rifles only
- No muzzle breaks – (We are shooting in squads and breaks distract other shooters)
- A2 type flash hiders and suppressors OK
- Prizes for best E & A cat shooters

- All matches shot at 100 yards on figure 12 targets.
- Eye and ear protection required (sunglasses & reading glasses OK)
- Bring a chamber flag if you have one.
- Match director's ruling final
- Bring your firearms license with you to register.
